
How to add my domain as sender?

In order to send from your own domain you need to delegate it to nameservers:

ns1.flynet.pro
ns2.flynet.pro

Go to Client area bill.flynet.pro -> Products/Services -> [VPS hosting](#) -> select string with needed server -> "Instructions" button -> find 'Hestia LAMP control panel' chapter on instructions page

Go to Hestia LAMP control panel - > Web -> 'Add Web Domain' button

Generate password
Press 'Save' button

Now you can use just created SMTP credentials in any SMTP mailer (external too).

For better delivery rate create DKIM sign for domain
Go to Hestia LAMP control panel -> Mail -> your just created domain -> 'Edit mail domain' icon (pencil) -> check 'DKIM' checkbox - press 'Save' button

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
